There are several great spectating opportunities for the Headwaters Rally May 20 in the Paul Bunyan Forest. Be sure to arrive a half hour before the stated times in order to park and make the short walk to the spectator area. Here's what you can see tonight:

**UNTIL 5:00 and again at 8:45 PM Thorpe Tower:** Take County Road 2 north from Nevis 9.3 miles to its end. Turn right on County 91. In 2.8 miles, turn right on Steamboat Road. The spectator area is 1 mile east on Steamboat. **Note: This entrance closes at 5:00 PM.** If you aren't in by 5:00, you'll need to use the Mantrap 17 entrance. This entrance will reopen around 7:30 PM for the 8:45 stage.

**Thorpe Tower  
(until 5:00 PM)  
and 8:45 PM**

**5:30 PM Mantrap 17:** Take County Road 2 north from Nevis. A mile after the pavement ends, go straight onto Mantrap 17 (2 goes left). 2 miles later, at the delta, go right on Spur 1. Then, in 1.2 miles, go left on Thorpe Tower. The spectator area is 2.4 miles north on Thorpe Tower.

## 2006 Headwaters Spectator Stages

**6:45 and 9:30 PM Steamboat:** Take MN 64 north 4.3 miles from MN 34 in Akeley. Turn right on Steamboat Road. The spectator area is 1.4 miles east on Steamboat. You'll be able to stay here the entire time if you don't want to move between stages.

**7:30 PM Akeley Service:** You can see the crews working on the cars up close during the Akeley Service. The service takes place on MN 34 right downtown Akeley.
