Numbered instructions only, no LRIs, no Aristotle traps, no unpaved traps, no 'in the absence of' traps. Your ability to determine the main road will be tested often. There will be both open & DIYC controls. Free zones will be used extensively.

What To Expect

Quantum Leap uses both numbered instructions & a map, which has "stripes" of red, yellow and blue. These "stripes" represent the energy or quantum level in which you are traveling. As you travel from quantum level to quantum level you emit energy – pause, or you absorb energy – gain. The interaction between the map & numbered route instructions as well as your ability to determine the main road will be tested. There will be both open & DIYC controls. Free zones will be used extensively.

We'll finish around 2 PM at The Kreekside Pub & Eatery, where a light lunch will be provided by the committee. The early finish should allow you plenty of time to get to your return flight,
